AVANT GARDE OBJECT 2013:

Avant Garde object, now in its 2nd year, is a Live Eco sustainable design competition that requires students to create an upcycled object according to a specified brief, using only used paper, plastic and metal; while adhering to eco-friendly, natural techniques.

The competition is open to all Design Time students, an interior design school, in Cape Town. Finalists will be eligible to showcase their objects at a unique exhibition in Cape Town later in the year*.

AVANT GARDE OBJECT THEME 2013: "STORAGE" THE BRIEF:

Students will be required to create **ONE** upcycled object from **USED** paper, plastic or metal, around the theme "STORAGE".

The idea is for the object not to resemble the material in its original form i.e. The material needs to change its form. For example, you cannot simply join plastic bottle tops together, the form of the bottle top needs to change.

Object dimensions: Minimum size 300mmx300mm. Maximum size - the object must be easily transportable.

*All materials need to be sourced by the students themselves.

SUBMISSION:

Each and every submission must contain the following digital submission as well as a 1:1 final object:

1. 1 page for the introduction of the idea / concept
2. 1 page for initial design ideas
3. 2 pages for design development
4. 1 page for manufacturing process
5. 1 page detailing written design concept (maximum 100 words)

* Format of each page:

- A4 (**PLEASE COMBINE ALL 6 PAGES INTO SINGLE PDF DIGITAL DOCUMENT**)
- Full name to appear on **each page**

ALL DIGITAL SUBMISSIONS MUST BE UPLOADED VIA THE LIVE ECO WEBSITE. OBJECTS TO BE SUBMITTED AT DESIGN TIME.

The student with the most creative images of their design process, uploaded to Instagram with the hashtag #avantgardeobject, also stands to win a prize.
